Group/School Requirements & Benefits:

- ✓ Discounted group/school rates are available for advance bookings of 10 or more.
- ✓ Advanced pre-paid reservations are required for a minimum of 14 days prior to the visit date.
- ✓ One adult chaperone must accompany every 5 children (grades K-12).
- ✓ Receive one free adult ticket with every 5 child tickets purchased. Complimentary tickets will automatically be added to the cart during the checkout process.
- ✓ Tax Exempt rates are available. Please visit our website to purchase tickets.
- ✓ Tax Exempt form must be available at the time of purchase.
- ✓ <u>Title I rates are available</u>. Please visit our website to purchase tickets.

Visit Duration:

✓ The tour through the attraction is self-guided. It should take you approximately 60 to 90 minutes (about 1 and a half hours) to complete your tour. However, you may take as little or as long as you need to experience the entire attraction. Plan for a 2–3-hour visit.

Group Hours of Operation:

- ✓ Group rates are available Monday Friday*

Group/School Booking Process:

- ✓ All reservations must be made through our website.
- ✓ If paying with check, please bring in check at least 14 days prior to the visit date.
- ✓ Group/School tickets are timed & dated.
- ✓ Receive an instant email confirmation.
- ✓ Choose electronic tickets or print at home tickets.
- ✓ <u>Tax Exempt rates are available</u>. Please email your tax-exempt form to <u>Atlanta@LEGODiscoveryCenter.com</u> to receive the tax-exempt purchase option. We will contact you within 72 business hours to discuss and confirm your request.

Group Payment:

- ✓ Payments can be made with a credit card at time of booking.
- ✓ Payment types accepted: Visa, MasterCard, American Express, and Discover.
- ✓ If paying with check, please bring in check at least 14 days prior to the visit date.
- ✓ Additional tickets can be added to your original reservation after your order is made. Purchasing additional tickets can be done on the day of your visit in our admissions area.
- ✓ If your group size is smaller than initially planned, you can utilize any extra tickets for another group/school visit within the same calendar year as your original booking. We <u>cannot</u> process partial refunds for group/school tickets.
- ✓ We are a <u>cashless attraction</u>. Any additional add-ons or purchases such as the Virtual Reality experience, Café items, Souvenir photos, or LEGO® products from our retail shop must be purchased via Credit or Debit card.

Group/School Cancellation, Reschedule and No-Show Policy:

- ✓ <u>From 85 South:</u> Take 85 South to Lenox Road/Cheshire Bridge, Exit 88. Turn right off exit onto Lenox Road. Phipps Plaza will be 2.5 miles ahead. Park bus at bus parking located under the mall by Atlanta Fire Station 3.
- ✓ <u>From 85 North:</u> Take 85 North to Exit 87 to GA 400, then take Exit 2. Turn right off exit to Lenox Road. From GA 400: Take GA 400 South to Lenox Road, Exit 2. Turn left off exit onto Lenox Road. Park bus at bus parking located under the mall by Atlanta Fire Station 3.
- ✓ <u>From 75 South:</u> Take 75 South to 85 North (follow 85 North directions) From 75 North: Take 75 North to 85 North (follow 85 North directions). Park bus at bus parking located under the mall by Atlanta Fire Station 3.

Arriving at the Attraction:

Bus Drop Off & Parking

- ✓ Turn on Longleaf Dr NE from Wieuca Rd NE between the Cortland Apartments and Nordstrom/AC Hotel parking garage.
- ✓ Park in the Bus Lane on your right.
- ✓ Look for the staircase on the right with the sign that says "LEGO Discovery Center Access Mall Level..."
- ✓ Enter the staircase and go up to the very top level/deck and head toward the mall entrance with the LEGO signs.
- ✓ Once inside the mall, look for the escalators on the right and go up to the 3rd floor
